Dear Student:

The Health Services Department would like to welcome you to SUNY Sullivan. Our office is located at H-016. We are open for nurse's hours Monday through Friday from 8am – 4pm. The office is closed daily from 1-2pm for lunch. Doctor's hours are Tuesday and Wednesday from 9-1pm and Thursdays from 9-11am. Appointments are preferred however, walk-ins are welcome. *The following is due in the Health Office by the 30th day of classes. This is mandated by the NYS Dept. of Health. Don't run the risk of being withdrawn from your classes.*

I. Everyone born after January 1, 1957 and who is planning to register for six or more campus-based credits must provide the following:

Proof of immunizations

- 2 Measles Vaccinations
- 1 Mumps Vaccination
- 1 Rubella Vaccination

II. IMMUNIZATION RECORDS CAN BE OBTAINED FROM:

- Your High School
- Your Family Physician
- Transfers-Last College Attended

- III.** Effective August 15, 2003, NYS Public Health Law makes it mandatory for **ALL** college students taking 6 or more credits on campus to receive information about **Meningococcal Meningitis Disease and Vaccine**. **ALL** students **MUST** have a record or receiving the Meningitis Vaccine **OR** sign a **WAIVER** declining the vaccine.
- IV.** **ALL Culinary, Respiratory, Nursing and Medical Assistant students:** You will need a test for tuberculosis, known as a **MANTOUX** or **PPD** (including results) within the last six months and a **TETANUS** vaccine that is within the last **10 years**. (**TETANUS** vaccine is not required for Medical Assistant students) These should be sent to the Health Services Office along with the above mentioned immunizations.
