WE WELCOME ALL APPLICANTS; HOWEVER, ENROLLMENT IN THE HONORS PROGRAM IS LIMITED. WE WILL INVITE PROSPECTIVE STUDENTS TO JOIN THE PROGRAM BASED ON A NUMBER OF FACTORS. EVIDENCE OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS SHOULD BE INCLUDED WITH YOUR APPLICATION.

Strong academic performance as shown by grade point average, class rank, and scores on the SAT or ACT exams

A letter of reference from a high school counselor, teacher, or someone with personal knowledge of your academic excellence

A letter indicating your interest in our program, which will serve as a writing sample, discussing the following aspects: Leadership position held in community, occupational groups, and any other evidence you deem relevant to your qualification for this program

A portfolio (if applicable)

A SUNY application for undergraduate admission to Sullivan County Community College

THE HONORS PROGRAM SCHOLARSHIP

The Honors Scholarship is awarded to students accepted to the Honors Program, according to the following student designations:

- Early Admit (high school) Students: \$500 per semester, for a total of \$1000 per year
- International Students: \$700 per semester, for a total of \$1,400 per year
- Any student who graduates in the top 10% of his/her class in Sullivan County and is accepted into the Honors Program will receive the cost of tuition and fees, less PELL, TAP and any SCCC Scholarships for the Fall and Spring Semesters. (minimum \$500)
- All Other Students: A minimum award of \$500 per semester over and above any PELL, TAP, and any other SCCC scholarships, and a maximum award of \$1,400 per semester over and above any PELL, TAP, and any other SCCC scholarships.

Students must make application for state and federal financial aid, and completed applications must be on file prior to May 1 of the preceding academic year. The Honors Scholarship is renewable based on a college grade point average of 3.25 (Dean's List status) and will be awarded for a maximum of four semesters.
