## CERTIFICATE OF RESIDENCY INSTRUCTIONS

What is a Certificate of Residency? Why do I need one?

As required by New York State Education Laws Section 6305 and 6301, a student must prove their residency in both their home county and New York State prior to beginning classes at a community college in New York State.

A Certificate of Residence will eliminate the non-resident tuition charge. Failure to comply will result in you being charged a non-resident surcharge of up to the cost of your tuition.

You can find the directions and applications on our website, <a href="https://www.sunysullivan.edu">www.sunysullivan.edu</a>. Click on *current student*, *student services*, *student billing*. You will see the "Certificate of Residence" application tabs on the right side of the page. If your county is not listed, use the attached application and contact your specific county for instructions. There is a "County Address/Phone Listing" at the bottom of the county tabs for your information.

Certificates must be dated no more than 60 days prior and 30 days after the first day of the semester, and are valid for 1 year. **Applications are not to be sent to Sullivan County Community College**.
