Articulation Agreement

between

Sullivan County Community College

and

Sullivan County Board of Cooperative Educational Services

This agreement is entered into between Sullivan County Community College, Loch Sheldrake, NY, herein referred to as the College, and the Sullivan Board of Cooperative Educational Services, Liberty, NY, herein referred to as BOCES.

Under the following terms and conditions, the College agrees to grant credit in its Criminal Justice (A.A.S.) Curriculum as specified below:

1. The student must meet all applicable College admissions requirements and be admitted to the College.
2. The student will have completed the 2-year BOCES Public Safety Services Program with a minimum grade point average of 75 or higher and have obtained a recommendation from a BOCES Public Safety Services instructor.
3. The student must complete at least 12 credit hours at the College with a minimum grade point average of 2.0.

Students meeting the above terms and conditions will be granted credit as follows, which equates to one semester of SUNY Sullivan's Criminal Justice degree:

3 Credits for CRJ 1115 Introduction to Criminal Justice
3 Credits for CRJ Elective by advisement
4 Credits Introduction to Forensic Science
3 Credits for CRJ 2111 Juvenile Justice
2 Credits for PED Elective

4. This agreement may be terminated at the request of the College or BOCES with one semester's notice and shall be reviewed every year by the Dean of Liberal Arts and Sciences at the College and BOCES. Any College or BOCES curricular changes affecting this agreement shall mandate modification or termination of the agreement.
