EDUCATION LAW, Section 6305 provides "The chief fiscal officer of each county, as defined in section 2.00 of the Local Finance Law, shall upon application and submission to him of satisfactory evidence, issue to any person desiring to enroll in a community college as a non-resident student a certificate of residence showing that said person is a resident of said county. Such person shall, upon registration for each college year, file with the college such a certificate of residence ISSUED NOT EARLIER THAN TWO MONTHS PRIOR THERETO, and such a certificate of residence shall be valid for one year from date of issuance."

EDUCATION LAW, Section 6301, paragraph 4, defines: Resident- A person who has resided in the state for a period of at least one year and in the county, city, town, immediate school district or school district, as the case may be, for a period of at least six months, both immediately preceding the date of such persons registration in a

community college, or for the purpose of Section 6305 of this chapter his application for a certificate of residence.

In the event that a person qualified as above for state residence, but has been a resident of two or more counties in the state during the six months immediately preceding his/her application for a certificate of residence pursuant to Section 6305 of this chapter, the charges to the counties of residence shall be allocated among the several counties proportional to the number of months, or major fraction thereof, of residence in each county.

CERTIFICATE OF RESIDENCY INSTRUCTIONS

What is a Certificate of Residency? Why do I need one?

As required by New York State Education Laws Section 6305 and 6301, a student must prove their residency in both their home county and New York State prior to beginning classes at a community college in New York State.

A Certificate of Residence will eliminate the non-resident tuition charge. Failure to comply will result in you being charged a non-resident surcharge of up to the cost of your tuition.

You can find the directions and applications on our website, www.sunysullivan.edu. Click on *current student, student services, student billing*. You will see the “Certificate of Residence” application tabs on the right side of the page. If your county is not listed, use the attached application and contact your specific county for instructions. There is a “County Address/Phone Listing” at the bottom of the county tabs for your information.

Certificates must be dated no more than 60 days prior and 30 days after the first day of the semester, and are valid for 1 year. **Applications are not to be sent to Sullivan County Community College.**
