We will not be offering a Refresher Course this summer.

EMT-B Tuition Rate is \$700, due in FULL prior to the start of class. Certification exam fees and text book materials are the student's responsibility. SUNY Mandate requires all students with an on campus presence to be FULLY vaccinated, as well as have their first Booster.

If a student is sponsored by a qualifying agency, upon passing the NYS exam and obtaining their certification, the agency may request tuition reimbursement through NYS Bureau of Emergency Medical Services. Sponsors will need to submit the NYS Dept. of Health 3312 verification form.
