



# Admissions Criteria and Rubric for the Nursing Program

## Admissions Rubric for Nursing AAS

### ATI TEAS Entrance Exam Score Conversion

78 > = 60 points  
75 > = 50 points  
70 > = 40 points  
68 > = 30 points  
65 > = 20 points  
58 > = 10 points  
<58 = 0 points

### GPA Conversion

4.0 = 40 points  
3.8 > = 35 points  
3.5 > = 30 points  
3.0 > = 25 points  
2.8 > = 20 points  
2.5 > = 10 points  
<2.5 = 0 points

TEAS score points and GPA points are added together, and applicants must achieve a total of 50 points in order to be eligible for acceptance into the program. Seats will be offered to applicants with the highest totals until all seats are filled. Additional qualified applicants will be placed on a Waiting List. In the event that accepted students decline their seats in the program, applicants from the Waiting List will then be offered seats and notified by the Director of Nursing Programs via letter.

### Average/GPA Minimums

High School Average- 85 or higher  
**OR**  
College GPA- 2.5 or higher

### Math Competency

The applicant meets Math competency using any **ONE** of the following:

- New York State Regents Exam with a score of 75 or higher
- ACT Math with a score of 17 or higher

- SAT Math with a score of 450 or higher
- College transfer credit of an equivalent Math course with a grade of C or higher

### **English Competency**

The applicant meets English competency using any **ONE** of the following:

- New York State Regents Exam with a score of 78 or higher
- ACT English with a score of 17 or higher
- SAT Critical Reading (Verbal) with a score of 480 or higher
- College transfer credit of an equivalent English course with a grade of C or higher

### **Science Competency**

The applicant meets Science competency using any **ONE** of the following:

- High School Biology/Living Environment with a grade of 70 or higher
- AP Biology (3 or higher)
- College transfer credit of an equivalent Science course with a grade of C or higher

### **\*\*Aged Science Credits**

Science credits earned more than 7 years prior to the start of the student's first Nursing semester will not satisfy program or application competency requirements. Students must retake any applicable Sciences that are more than 7 years old.
