

2024-2025 Financial Aid Application Procedures

After December 1, 2023, you may complete the 2024-2025 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at studentaid.gov. Questions will be based on your 2022 income. When filing your 2024-2025 FAFSA, you are giving consent to link to the IRS from the FAFSA and retrieve tax information directly from the IRS to populate the FAFSA tax return questions. Your parent, (if dependent) will also be asked to give consent on-line with a FSA ID and password which you can apply for during the application process. (Sullivan's Federal School Code is 002879.)

NYS Residents complete the NYS Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) Application. You may complete this application through the web link at the end of the FAFSA on-line. If you miss the link, NYSHESC will e-mail a link where you will be able to access the on-line TAP Application. To check your TAP status, go to www.hesc.ny.gov.

Complete the Admission Procedures. You must be admitted to SUNY Sullivan in a matriculated program and be in good academic standing to receive financial aid.

When your FAFSA is received, you may be selected for a process called verification. We will be contacting you for additional documentation, such as 2022 income. <u>Please Note</u>: If we are requesting your 2022 Federal Tax Return, make sure it is signed and all applicable schedules are turned in.

If you are applying for a Federal Direct Subsidized/Unsubsidized Loan, you must complete the above steps and the Federal Direct Loan Request Form and return the form to the Financial Aid Office. You must also complete the Master Promissory Note AND the Federal Entrance Counseling for SUNY Sullivan online at studentaid.gov.

Hand in all outside private scholarships to the Financial Aid Office.

Also please note: Financial Aid Award Letters will be issued to students with complete financial aid applications on a rolling basis. You must sign and date the Financial Aid Award Letter, along with the Financial Aid Policies and Conditions and the Title IV Authorization Form and return the signed copies to the Financial Aid Office. Once you have registered and have received your Financial Aid Award Letter, you should contact the Student Billing Office regarding your student bill for your tuition, fees and miscellaneous charges, along with your Certificate of Residence.
