MEETING OF THE SULLIVAN COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FINANCE COMMITTEE MINUTES July 18, 2024

The meeting was called to order at 2:38pm.

ACTION ITEMS:

All items were tabled because there was no quorum to take a formal action.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

A.) Financial Reports

- S. Welsh reported,
 - Revenues and Expenditures reflected are through June.
 - Cash on hand is \$2,590,025.67.
 - Money Market account, which includes restricted funds is \$1,425,548.08
 - The Perkins account will be closing once we complete processing of the loans.
 - Student revenue is greater than anticipated, and chargebacks are less.
 - All state-aid has been received for the fiscal year, and was \$78,334 more than what was budgeted.
- D. Potash reported,
 - Both he and S. Welsh are continuing to work with Chief Financial Officer (CFO) at SUNY to develop a plan for the NYSHIP debt. Would like to get repayment down to an amount in comparison of what was paid out on behalf of our employees.
 - Currently, retirees are contacting the Office of Human Resources for help with processing claims, which is causing a staffing problem.
 - Asked that the Finance Committee set-up a sub-committee to review retiree benefit process and policy development.
- S. Jaffee noted that cash on hand is less than what is in the bank. S. Welsh noted this is due to the outstanding checks.
- P. Guenther, asked for a list of concerns for the end of this fiscal year going into the next year.
 - D. Potash noted,
 - NYSHIP
 - Meeting enrollment goals for next year

B.) Enrollment Update

- D. Potash shared,
 - We are ahead of where we were this time last year.
 - Across the county 22% of community College enrollment is contributed to high school students.

C.) Rental Fee Schedule

- S. Welsh reported,
 - Looking to grow our relationships with the community and usage of our campus.
 - Kept all fees the same as last year except security, which under the new contracts is a lower per hour rate.
